



USE OF NEW METHODS IN LEARNING ENGLISH

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Annotation: When learning new languages, a person faced various difficulties, and learning English is not easy task. A few years ago, it was very difficult to learn English, people could learn only by memorizing vocabulary and grammar rules. Today, new methods have been developed and this work has been much easier. This article provides information about new methods.

As of November 2022, the world population is estimated to be more than billion people. As a large part of the world's population communicates in English. Today, English is the native language of 345 million people, and 370 million people speak it as a second language. Moreover, the number of English language learners is increasing day by day as it is becoming a world language. Learning a language is a complex task and people face various difficulties during learning. It is natural to have such difficulties in English. A few years ago, learning English only consisted of memorizing vocabulary and learning grammar rules but scientists have come up with easy and effective methods, one of them is "Booknomy". "Booknomy" produced 2 different ways. In the first type, everyone opens the audio by scanning and follow the book by listening. The second type was recently developed, according to which one learn language using a tablet which is very convenient for everybody to carry with them. By these methods humans learn not only English but also other 5 languages. They are: Turkish, Korean, Arabic, Russian languages.

In addition, many other methods of learning English have been developed. We will introduce the most popular of them.



1. **Schechter's methods.** Igor Yuryevich Shekhter suggested the use of this method. In the first lesson, children are given a task. They learn each other's professions, play different games, they communicate and learn easily.

2. **Pimsler methods.** This method developed by Dr.Pimsler in a system of 30 minute lesson. Lessons are taught by 2 teachers, a native language teacher and an English teacher. Children learn hundreds of phrases during the lesson.

3. **Dragunkin method.** This method was developed by Dragunkin. He said that "English is very easy and that the language is rooted in Russian". Dragunkin offered his book "A little Leap into English". However, this method has been widely criticized and found to be ineffective.

4. **Petrol method.** Dmitriy Petrov says that you can learn English in 16 hours. This is enough to explain your needs if you find yourself in an environment of English speakers.

Also, there are several more modern methods. They are:

1. **Creative problem solving.** In this method, the beginning part of the story is read and the students have to find the end part by themselves.

2. **Quick answer** in which the students are asked a question about the topic covered.

3. **Pantomime** – explaining different words through gestures. It is correct if this method is used for students to have fun while passing difficult topics.

4. **A chain story.** A story is told by the teacher. In this, students' oral speech develops well.

5. **When pictures speak.** In this way student's speech develops well. Pictures are used during the lesson

In conclusion, English is difficult to learn, but everyone can learn any language quickly and effectively if everybody chooses the method that suits and follow the rules of this method. He should work tirelessly in learning this language and ask the teacher what he does not understand. The teacher should choose the appropriate and explain the correct learning methods to the student. Then it can be easier not only learning English, but also other languages.
