He continued to prepare constantly to recover his health and prove himself once again. Malinin's flying style represents a blend between technical skills and the expression of creativity. It combines a complex jumping sequence with modern step movements and emotional choreography, providing the viewer with an engaging stage presentation. Personal life Malinin draws attention not only to her sporting career, but also to her personal life. He also dedicates time to his hobbies, such as listening to music and learning according to his interests. Spending time with family and friends motivates and reduces stress. He attributes his success in the sport to his family and coaches, who constantly support him.

Misha Ge, full name Misha Aloyzievich Ge, was born on 17 May 1991 in Moscow, Russia. His parents are figure skating coaches, and Misha started skating at an early age due to his interest in the sport. Starting at the age of 4, Misha began learning ice skating, which allowed her to perfectly combine dance and technique at the same time. Members of the family, particularly his mother, Larisa Ge, spent time with him, conducting programs and exercises aimed at creating perfect figures.

In 2009, Misha joined the national team of Uzbekistan and had the opportunity to showcase his high talent on the international stage. In the competitions he participated in, he always strived to further improve his technical skills and artistic expression. With each performance, Misha established high standards in Uzbekistan figure skating.

The 2014 Winter Olympics in Sochi, Russia, became an important turning point for Misha Ge. He represented Uzbekistan and demonstrated his creative skills. His performances in Sochi impressed audiences not only technically but also artistically. In 2018, Misha Ge decided to end his athletic career, but he did not move away from the ice. Today, she is coaching and choreographing, sharing her knowledge, experience, and creative approach with young figure skaters.

Misha's coaching style has many facets, he teaches young athletes not only the technique of figure skating, but also the expression of feelings on the stage. It inspires students to freely express themselves on stage, understand the music, and add their emotions to the dance. Ilia Malinin won her biggest achievement at Skate Canada in 2022, finishing 1st. His lowest score was in 2022 when he took 4th place at the Winter Olympics.

In conclusion, it can be noted that when comparing Misha Ge and Ilia Malinin in terms of success and low performance in figure skating, the achievements of both athletes are unique and impressive, and their contributions to the sport of figure skating are of great importance. Misha Ge has represented Uzbekistan in a number of international competitions and was the 1st runner-up at the 2010 Uzbekistan Championships. However, her 17th-place finish at the Sochi 2014 Olympic Games is remembered as her lowest performance. Ilia Malinin, who is one of the athletes shaping the future of figure skating with her creative and technical approach, finished 1st at the 2022 Skate Canada. Malinin's lowest score is 4th place at the 2022 Winter Olympics. Both athletes' unique abilities, strong mental state, and dedication to the sport led them to take their place in the world of figural flying. Their achievements are widely recognized on a global sporting scale, increasing the likelihood of achieving even greater success in the future.
